Hello to all our Missouri members and cake decorator friends!

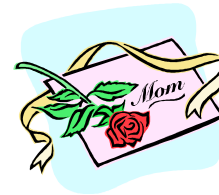

Interesting Information

How do chocolate transfers work?

- Simply temper your chocolate following the instructions on the packet.
- Trim the transfer sheet to the required size, place it onto a non-stick board with the cocoa butter facing upwards and pour the tempered chocolate over the sheet until it is completely covered.
- Once the chocolate is approx 2mm-3mm deep, place the sheet in the fridge and leave the chocolate to go slightly matt.
- Use a sharp knife to cut the chocolate into strips (depending on what size or shape you need them to be), then place in the fridge for a further 20 minutes.
- Wearing clean, white cotton gloves, remove the chocolate slices from the fridge. Place a cake board on top of the chocolate and carefully flip it over. Peel off the transfer sheet (which should now be on the top), being careful to avoid touching the surface of the chocolate.

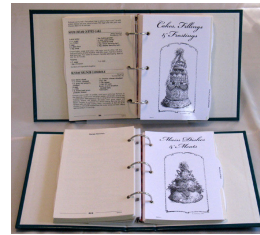
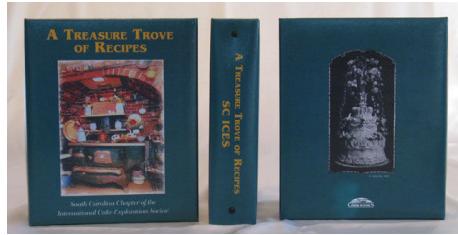

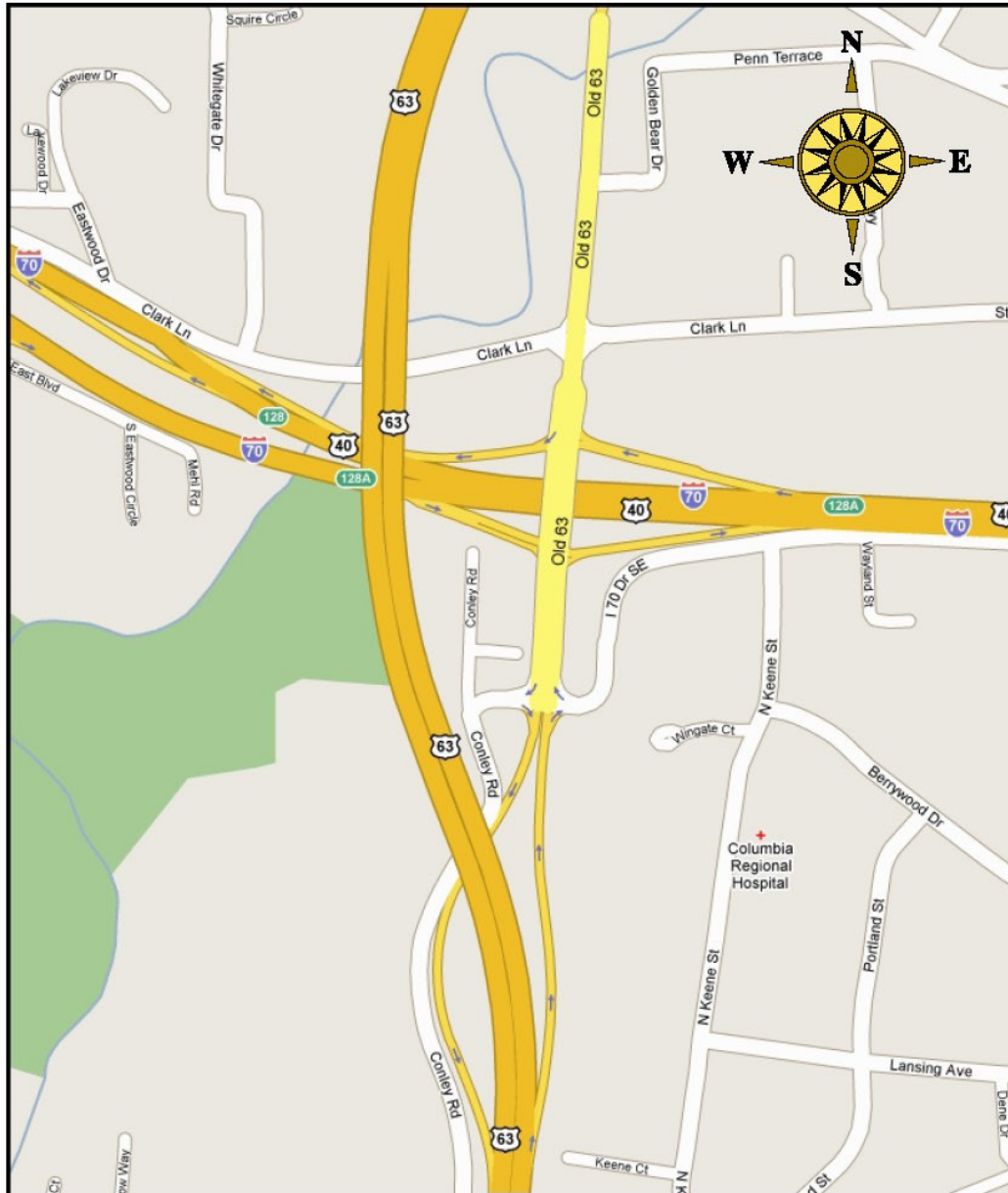

Directions to Columbia Regional Hospital Conference Rooms 404 Keene St, Columbia MO 65201

From I-70, exit onto US-63 South (Old 63) toward Jefferson City.

Turn Left at first stop light onto I-70 Drive SE.

Turn Right on Keene St (this will be the first **street** to the right).

You will see Columbia Regional Hospital on your left.

Enter at the "Main Hospital Entrance"; watch for a sign with this marking. Turn Left onto the Hospital grounds. Directly ahead, you will see the double doors that enter the Conference Room area. Parking is available in the lot on your right.

(Do Not enter the Health Pavilion double doors)
